

Father and son team to compete in Kempsey Off Road Race

When it comes to the sport of Off Road Racing there are many families involved, and such is the case with the Hasting Valley father and son team of Len and Chris Levi.

The duo has a long history in the sport, with Len originally being the driver and Chris the navigator. In recent times the roles have reversed with Chris proving adept in the driver's seat.

Over the weekend of May 29 / 30 the duo will compete in the Wittittrin 200 west of Kempsey. It will be the third time in the six year history of the race that the pair has competed, and on both previous occasions Chris was the driver. In 2005 they finished 7th outright and 2nd in class, while in 2008 it was 17th outright and 5th in class.

After taking a year off to regroup, the Levi team, with Chris driving, is back on track and ready for success in 2010. Still campaigning their trusty Manxco Class 2 machine the duo started the year with a 3rd outright and first in class in Round 1 of the NSW Off Road Championship at Dondingalong (Kempsey) and followed that up with another class win and a second outright in Round 2 held at Crookwell in the south of the state.

The Levi team will be hoping it's good fortune continues in Round 3 of the state series at Wittittrin. The Wittittrin course features tough forest sections, and fast paddock straights. For more information on the Wittittrin 200 visit www.kempseyoffroadracing.net
